



Lunch and Breakfast Program

All students may apply for free/reduced breakfast and/or lunch. Whether full price, reduced, or free, all students are encouraged to eat breakfast and lunch. Please see the Data Specialist, Mrs. Lisa Chancery, for information relative to application for free/reduced status. Also, parents may visit the district's Food Services website for more information.

All snack machines and/or drink machines will be off limits during the morning until one hour after the last served lunch, per Board Policy.

At no time will students have lunches delivered to campus from an outside vendor (food service...fast food establishments, restaurants, caterers, local stores, etc.) unless it is contracted through the school lunchroom program. Students may bring lunches with them to school in the morning; however, lunches may not be delivered to students during the school day.

Parents are encouraged to deposit money into their student's account in a timely manner. No foods in violation of the Smart Snack Policy may be sold by clubs, sports, and/or organizations during the school day, unless the sale has been approved as one of the days Northview may deviate from the Smart Snack Policy.
