

Guidelines for Tardy Tank

1. Tardy Tank for periods 2 thru 7 is announced on a randomly selected period. It is announced over the PA that the tardy bell has rung and that the teachers are not to admit any students to the class. ALL STUDENTS in the hallways or in unauthorized areas must then report to the cafeteria. This shall include the gym.
2. Students that are in the “Tardy Tank” (Cafeteria) are monitored by the ISS Coordinator. The students are kept there the entire period. They may not talk while in the Tank. ISS moves to cafeteria. Separate from Tardy Tank.
3. ISS coordinator or Dean takes roll. A copy of the list of students is then emailed to each teacher.
4. ALL TEACHERS are instructed to check the list of students kept in the “Tardy Tank,” mark them unexcused absent, and give them a zero on any graded work, including class participation.
5. Students who are habitually tardy disturb classes in progress. Car drivers will have their parking privilege taken away in increasing amounts of time. Repetitive measures will be for the rest of the year.

Dress Code

The district’s R&R handbook for students explains the dress code. The major infractions which occur at NHS can all be avoided. For females the problems are usually issues of exposure, holes in inappropriate places, and shortness of skirts/skorts/shorts/dresses. For males the problems are usually holes in inappropriate places, baggy/saggy pants, and over-sized top shirts.
